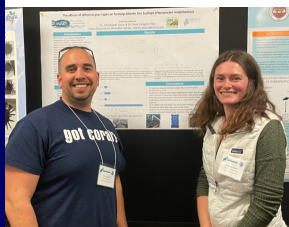


Amanda Mann Teacher of the Year
